We continued to the town of Gyula where the Gaboka farm was located and we tried different types of cheese and yellow cheese and also ate an organic burger.



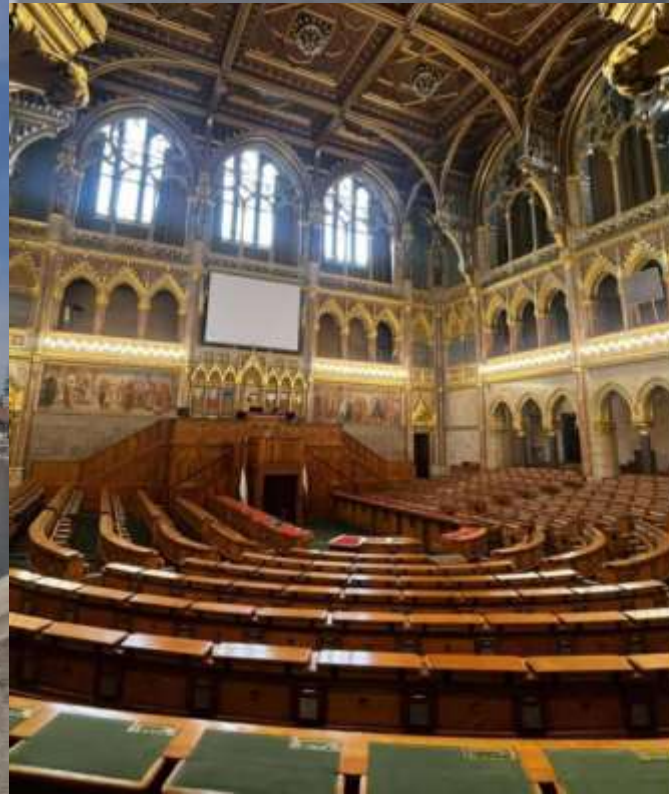
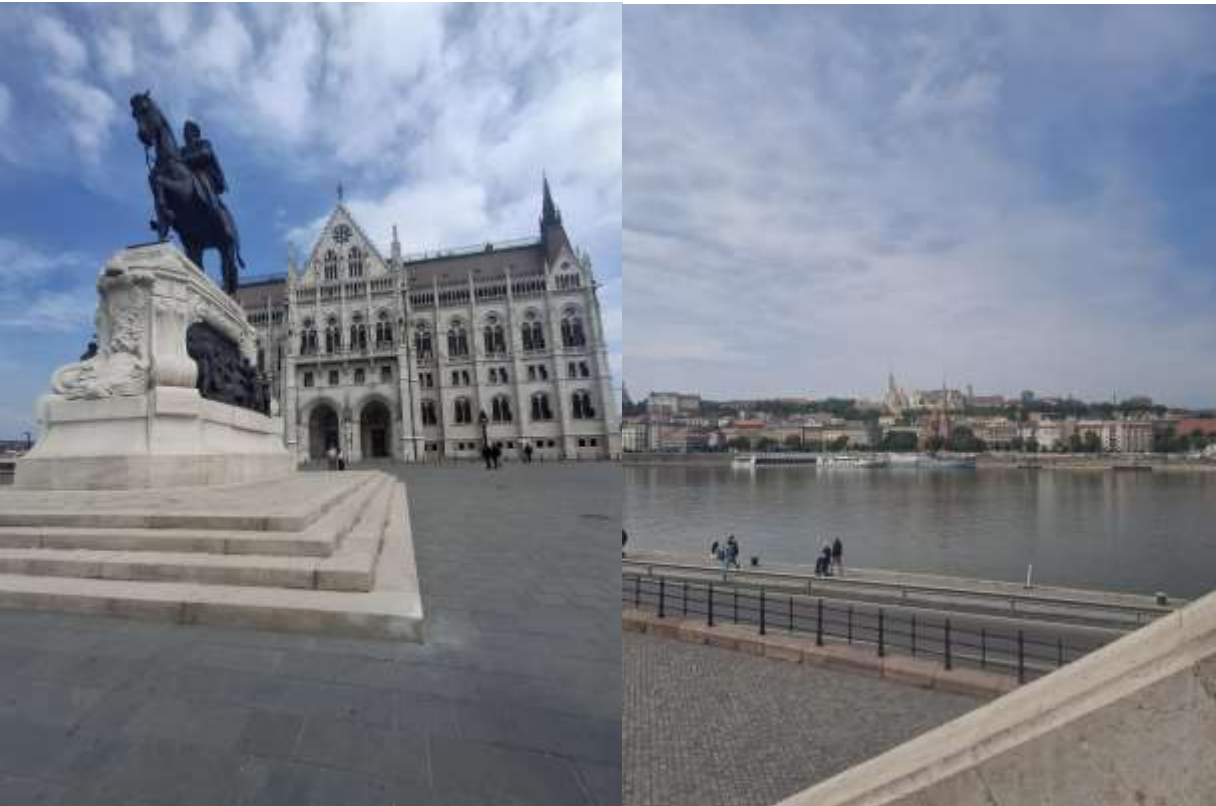







Third day

We started our third day in Hungary by traveling to Budapest, first we visited the parliament which was located on the left side of the Danube River and that part is called Pest.



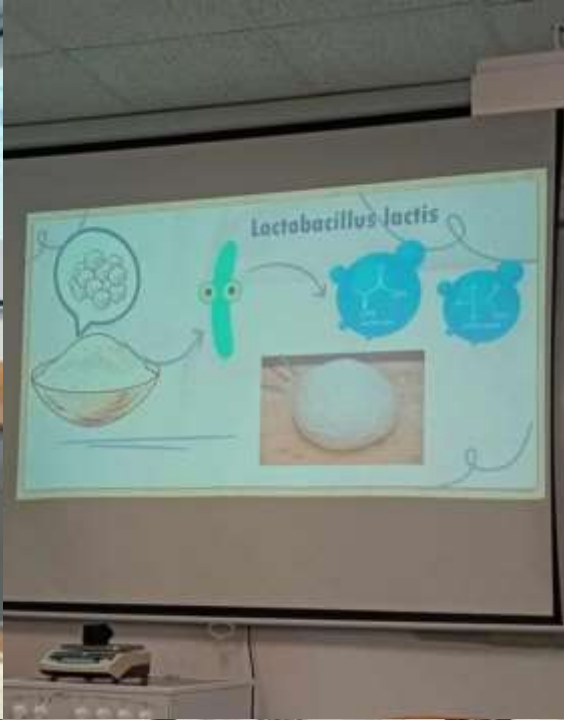


Later we visited the part called Buda where we visited the Fighters' Square, the theater and the opera. Buda and Pest are connected by the Szechenyi Bridge.†
